Good Evening. We hope all is well with everyone. If you have driven along Drauden Road in the last several months, you are aware of the change from a 4 lane to a 2-lane road. There is also a change in the turning lanes. This has and will have an impact on the how we drop off and pick-up students on a typical school day. If you are dropping your student off for school, you will enter school grounds at the Northmost entrance, this is the four way stop sign at Drauden Road and Arbor Gate Drive. Once you turn in, you will travel on the right side of the lane (passenger door closest to the houses) and proceed towards the back of the building. Follow the curve and back circle and proceed back alongside the curb, with passenger side of your vehicle on the same side of the school building. Pull up as far as you can (white line) and drop your student off.

For safety measures, it is important to wait until you complete the whole pathway before stopping and dropping your student off. Students will not be allowed to cross the lane to gain access the sidewalk.

Once you have dropped your student off, you will proceed to the four way stop sign and exit the school campus.
